Despite record Council Tax increases from County Hall, services are still being cut and our hard-earned money is being wasted.

The Conservatives have forced through their undemocratic parking scheme, which nine out of ten people in Eastbourne have said they are against. Local people are unlikely to see any benefit from the money collected from parking charges.

Stephen said “Millions of pounds is also being wasted on other unpopular schemes around the County, like the Incinerator in Newhaven, whilst services are being cut.”

Whilst the Conservative County Council has sent its share of Council Tax soaring, Lib Dem-run Eastbourne Council kept Council Tax low.

It's average tax increase was just £7.50 this year.
